

This year the Club welcomed many new members & their families into the pool membership without verification of successfully satisfying their charitable point obligation.



If you had not completed the seven (7) point requirement by the time you were accepted into the pool you are now required to satisfy an additional four (4) points, totaling eleven (11) before your second swim season begins. Failure to complete this charitable obligation will result in fortieture of membership along with the bond paid & application fee.






