Brothers, as we approach the end of calendar year 2013 we would like to remind all Brother Knights who still have outstanding dues owed to please send them to Tom Hornig our Financial Secretary before he starts sending out the Dues Notices for 2014. MESSAGE FROM THE GRAND KNIGHT



Brother Knights at Union Council 4504,

The month of November is a month of Remembrance and Thanksgiving. We start the month celebrating All Saints and All Souls Days. On All Saints Day we commemorate all those who have been Beatified as Saints. On All Souls Day we remember all our family members and friends who have passed away. At the Union Knights we also remember all our Deceased Brother Knights from our Council who have passed over the 56 years that our council has been in existence. This years Memorial Mass will be at 9:00 AM Mass on Sunday November 17, 2013 at Holy Spirit Church. Following the Mass we will hold our traditional Brunch in the Council Hall. Please join us as we come together as a Knights family to remember those who have left us.

During November we also celebrate Veterans Day. Every year on the 11th of November we honor all our Veterans. Veterans Day was originally called Armistice Day, and was intended to remember the end of World War I, which officially ended at the eleventh hour, of the eleventh day, of the eleventh month of 1918. Fund Raising with TD Bank


