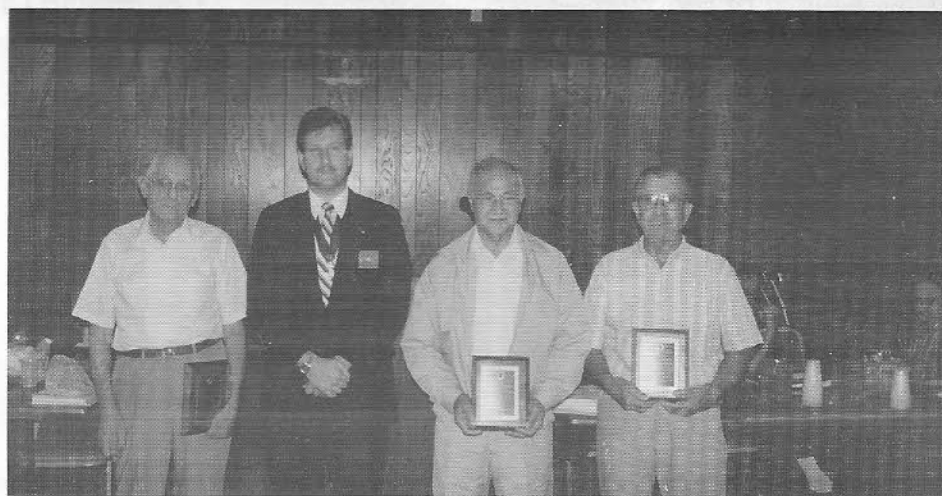

SUPREME COUNCIL OK'S NEW BENEFIT PACKAGE

The Supreme Council has given final approval to the new Fraternal Benefits package for members of the Order in good standing in their Council. Highlights of the package include an Accidental Death policy on members and their spouses, Guaranteed coverage for children (regardless of medical condition) and a death benefit to the family if a child dies less than 61 days after birth or is stillborn at least 20 weeks after conception. There is also an Orphan Benefit program for the children of deceased members and their spouse. Certain conditions apply to these new benefits and full details can be obtained from your Field Agent. Information about these new benefits are available to all members at no cost.
