HE'S COMING

Pope John Paul II will lead Knights of Columbus families and others in an evening prayer service beginning at 5PM, October 22 at Shea Stadium in New York. The family prayer service is being jointly hosted by the Knights of Columbus Supreme Council and the Diocese of Brooklyn, NY. The Pope will be in New York this Fall to deliver a major address to the UN General Assembly. His US trip will also include stops in New Jersey and Baltimore.

It is hoped that every jurisdiction will be represented at the prayer service in Shea Stadium. Specific details are currently being worked out. What can be said with certainty is that seating will be limited and that tickets for the event will be distributed through the state council. All reservations are to be made through the state councils. The state deputies have appointed coordinators for this event, and more information will be forthcoming from the state councils as details are worked out.

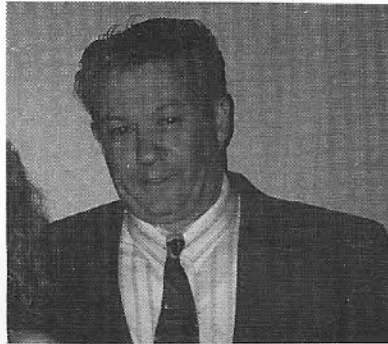
