March is upon us, and with it marks the beginning of forty days of glory and praise for Christ, through whom all things were made.

What better way to begin this month then by attending our council meeting on March 11, 1996, and joining us in prayer. I welcome you all to attend. These next forty days we all will make a Lenten sacrifice, and I hope that most of you do not give up attending council meetings.

It saddens me to see the number of members who attend our regular meetings. For the last five years as I have moved up the chairs and watched the Grand Knights before me, I realize that we all have had one thing in common, and that is to encourage our members to attend our council meetings. Our council is 1800 members strong and the average attendance at our council meetings is 60 brother knights, and that includes the officers. This means that only 3% of our membership partakes on issues and decisions that effect all of the 1800 members of this council.

At our February 12th council meeting the Columbian Club brought to the floor several bylaws changes that needed to be voted on. These changes were very important and effected all of us: we are part of the Columbian Club. Unfortunately, the attendance was the same at this meeting as it has always been: poor. Attending a council meeting is very important, it means taking an active roll in the council and helping us to make decisions that concern you, and to help guide this council in its growth, success, and its very existence.

We all joined this council for one reason or another, but whatever the reason was, we have lost that excitement, that spark, the enthusiasm that said "Hey! I am a member of the Knights of Columbus!" You need to discover that drive and dedication of your commitment of membership to the Knights of Columbus once again. Share with friends and family what the Knights are all about. And most of all find out how you can become more involved... Attend a council meeting!

## WORDS OF FAITH FROM POPE JOHN PAUL II

"In {the} catechesis on the Blessed Virgin Mary, we consider the passage from the Book of Genesis in which God's words to the serpent after the fall are particularly significant: 'I will put enmity between you and the women, and between your seed and her seed; He shall bruise your head, and you shall bruise His heel' (Gn 3:15). This divinely promised victory over sin will come about through the offspring of 'the woman,' the Son who is Christ the redeemer. But this first announcement of the Good News of salvation—the Proto-Gospel—also prophetically foreshadows Mary's maternal mission in the church. As the New Eve, she is conceived without sin and is completely devoted to overcoming the forces of sin and death."

"Through her cooperation with Christ in the work of salvation, Mary contributes in a unique way to the triumph over Satan. In solidarity with the Virgin of Nazareth, all women are called to fight against evil. Through personal and liturgical prayer, through catechetical work and the witness of charity, through vocations to the consecrated life and religious education in the family, they become the 'privileged partners' of God's saving plan. Mary's mission sheds light on the vocation of all humanity, and therefore on that of every woman, to cooperate with her Son in defeating the power of evil."

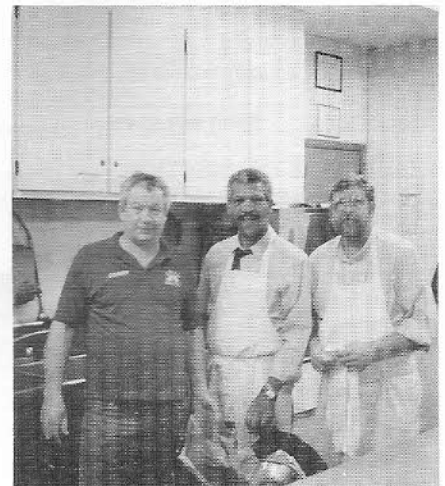
