# God of Second Chances By Msgr. Anselm, Chaplain

God of second, third, and fiftieth chances, I have so much love for this chapter in Scriptures taken from 2 Corinthians 12:9. "My grace is sufficient for you, for power is perfected in weakness. "On New Year's Day, 1929, Georgia Tech played University of California in the Rose Bowl. In that game a man named Roy Riegels recovered a fumble for California. Somehow, he became confused and started running in the wrong direction. One of his teammates, Benny Lom, overtook and downed him sixty-five yards away, just before he scored for the opposing team. When California attempted to punt, Tech blocked the kick and scored a safety, which was the ultimate margin of victory. When the first half ended, everybody wonder what Coach Nibbs Price will do with Roy Riegels in the second half? Back in the dressing room, everyone sat down on the benches and on the floor except Riegels who sat in the corner with his face in his hands, crying like a baby. Now coaches usually have a great deal to say to their teams during halftime, but on this day, coach Price was guiet. No doubt he was trying to decide what to do with Riegels. Then the timekeeper came in and announced "three minutes before playing time". Price looked at the team and said simply, "Men, the same team that played the first half will start the second." The players got up and started out, except Riegels. The coach looked back and called to him. Still he didn't move. Coach Price went over to him and said, "Roy, didn't you hear me? The same team that played the first half will start the second." Roy looked up, eyes red and wet with tears and said to the coach, "I can't do it. I need to save my life. I've ruined you, the University of California, and myself. I can't face that crowd in the stadium for the sake of my life." Coach Price put his hand on Riegels' shoulder and said to him: "Roy, get up and go on back; the game is only half over." Roy looked at him, got up and went back. The guys from

Georgia Tech will tell you they have never seen a man play football as Roy Riegels did during the second half. My fellow knights that is grace at work. Many a time, we take the ball and run in the wrong direction. We stumble, fall and are so ashamed of ourselves that we never want to try again. We must always remember that the sufficiency of God's grace happens in the context of human inability, insufficiency, brokenness, weakness, feelings of abandonment, of betrayal, of neglect, of disappointment, of insecurity. It may be feelings of discouragement or hopelessness after tireless attempts to control our temper, unhealthy impulses, or thoughts. It could be struggles with physical, emotional or spiritual exhaustion. No matter what it is, just remember that "there is sufficient grace" for our situations and God is bending over and saying to us, "Get up and get going; the game is only half over."

#### **Battalion Mass to Honor Saint Pio**

MASS IN HONOR OF SAINT PIO

On September 13th members of the JFK Assembly Color Corp attended the Battalion Mass Call out to the Cathedral Basilica, Newark to honor Saint Pio.


Five first-class relics of him were present during the day for veneration prior to the Mass. Padre was born in 1887 in Pietrelcina, Italy, and adopted the name "Pare Pio" in 1903. He was ordained a priest in 1910 and received the stigmata on September 20, 1918, making him the first

stigmatized priest in the history of the Catholic Church. He spent up to 14 hours a day hearing confessions.

He died in 1968, was beatified on May 2, 1999, and canonized by Pope John Paul II in 2002. He is the patron saint of Civil defense volunteers, adolescents, stress relief, and the January blues.
