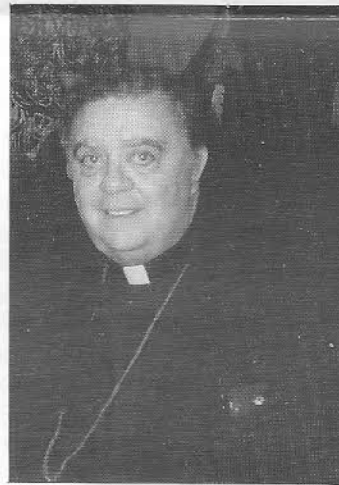

FATHER MALANGA APPOINTED CHAPLAIN

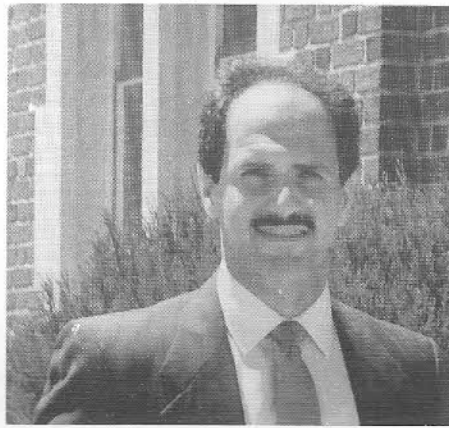
